October Speaker David Donnelly



Trenton, New Jersey December 22,1776

A letter from Joseph Reed (Pennsylvania Militia) to General George Washington:

"Will it not be possible, my dear General, for our troops or such part of them as can act with advantage to make a diversion or something more at or about Trenton? The greater the alarm, the more likely success will attend the attacks. I will not disguise my own sentiments that our cause is desperate and hopeless if we do not take the opportunity of the collection of troops at present to strike some stroke. Our affairs are hastening fast to ruin if we do not retrieve them by some happy event. Delay with us is now equal to total defeat."

On Christmas day December 25th, In the middle of the night, braving the treacherous Delaware River and the ice, General Washington and his troops crossed the Delaware and attacked and routed the Hessian troops, reigniting the revolution.
