Thirty years ago: The Cable Car system was shut down from 1982 to 1984, no service for a year. The Chamber of Commerce sponsored a first S. F. Historic Trolley Festival in 1983. The Chamber with Muni obtained cars from around the world and the U.S. with an assist from the Western Railway Museum in Solano County. Cars came from Portugal, Germany, Russia, the Blackpool Boat Car from Mexico, to name a few, (See last page). The festival was so successful that it came back for 3 more years.

The Chamber of Commerce eventually gave up the sponsorship. The Board, 7 member volunteer group which ran the trolley lines (prior of the sale to SF) headed by Harold Perazzo rescued coach 776 from the scrap heap. The board eventually became the "Friends of the Festival." The group proposed operation of an F Line running along Market street to the Ferry Building. This was accepted and later expanded to run along the Embarcadero. The policy of painting streetcars has been successful adding color to Market Street. A new E Embarcadero line will cover the entire Embarcadero from Fisherman's Wharf to Cal Train soon and there are plans for the tunnel under Fort Mason to the West end of Fort Mason.
