Little SIR Paul Rosenberg

For those of us who grew up in California, we remember September 9 as Admission Day. It was a holiday for schools, state and local government, state chartered banks, and others. There were times when we would start school after Labor Day and then a couple of days later we would have our first holiday. Slow starts were good

In some ways, the California constitution that was approved by the federal legislature and President Fillmore was forward looking in content. California became the first state to provide for the separate property of married women allowing them to retain any property owned before the marriage or any gifts afterward. [This had been part of Mexican law and there had been pressure to maintain it.] Henry Halleck argued to the legislature, made up mostly of unmarried men, that this law could attract wealthy women to California! Nevertheless, the original constitution was a product of its times and did not allow African Americans, Asian Americans, or Native Americans to vote [and no women could vote in California until 1911] or could these groups testify against a white man in the courts. This terrible discrimination was rectified by the current constitution of 1879.

At best, California when admitted on September 9, 1850, was a product of its time. A bit more forward looking than other states, it was not a bastion of progressive thinking. Yet, California mostly over it's soon to be 164 years continues to better itself. Our SIRs are all Californians and California is better for having organizations like our own. So, on Monday, September 9, take a moment to think of California even though many robbed us of the holiday for such considerations as making the day after Thanksgiving a holiday as a trade.
