A Salesforce Park Walking Tour FOR YOU.

Salesforce Park in downtown San Francisco is open! (from personal recent experience)

People are wearing masks and are social distancing, and this is enforced by the Salesforce Park Police, so there are no scofflaws, but there is full access.

A visit to the park is a wonderful experience. There are well-maintained plantings from Mediterranean climates from around the world, including ours. There is a pleasant flat paved meandering walk of about 4 city blocks in each direction. The views are spectacular – an oasis of nature in the midst of tall modern buildings.

The main walking entrance to the Salesforce Transit Center, the most impressive one, is located on Fremont Street between Mission and Howard. From there, it's a spectacular four-story escalator ride to the Park, on the "roof" of the Transit Center.

There is ample parking nearby:

- SP+ Parking at 65 Minna Street is the closest – it's valet parking right in the transit center call (415) 546-6041 for rates.
- 85 2nd Street Parking Garage is within a block (415) 777-4042
- 333 Market Garage is also within a block valet only (800) 925-7275
- 199 Fremont Garage (Impark Lot #344) also within a

block - valet only - (415) 227-0114

Personally, I make an extended walk of it, parking at the Yerba Buena Garage at Fifth and Mission. That's a four block walk each way, but an interesting one, and I'm familiar with the parking layout.

To whet your appetite for this walk, there is an informal Youtube guide to the Park by Mike Sullivan – author of "Trees of San Francisco":

This video follows Mike as he films and talks on his iPhone. The commentary is informative and entertaining.

This video was taken before the pandemic, accounting for the large number of people in the park. The walk is a good deal more private now – like you own personal garden with only a few interlopers.
